Reenactors keep area's 'History Alive'

Encampments, displays offer a look at the past

Historical reenactors recently set up camp at the Chesterfield Township Historical Village to offer a unique living history timeline of dress, daily life and wartime.

The Chesterfield Township Historical Society hosted the Lac Ste. Claire Voyageurs and "History Alive! A Timeline of Historical Reenactors" June 5 and 6. Eras from the early days of the fur trade through the war on global terror were represented by displays, encampments and reenactors from groups including the Voyageurs and Michigan Military Technical Historical Society.

Among the eras represented, a World War II chaplain display was expected to be set up in the school house, while a Vietnamera display was also planned.

Funds raised through the event will support continued programing at the historical village.

Next month, the historical society will host a World War II reenactment of Operation Cobra. The event, set to run from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. July 10 and 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. July 11, will feature two public battles and encampment and military vehicle displays.
